

Chulabhorn Royal Academy Chulabhorn Graduate Institute Announcement On Measures for the Control the COVID-19 Infection No. 4

Considering the current prevalence of COVID-19, which has been declared a dangerous contagious disease by the Ministry of Public Health, and the rapid surge in the number of people infected with the disease, and in compliance with the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration Announcement (No. 2), Section 15, dated 21 March 2020, ordering the a temporary closure of various places, the Institute hereby issues its operating procedures, as follows:

- 1. The Chulabhorn Graduate Institute is closed, and its personnel must be absent from work from 22 March 2020 to 12 April 2020.
- 2. All classroom teaching and learning activities must be suspended or continued online.
- 3. Research activities can still be conducted at the laboratory but must follow the safety standards prescribed by the Ministry of Public Health. Those coming to undertake such activities at the Institute building must fill in the report form placed in front of the elevator doors.
- 4. All security personnel must perform their usual duty of looking after the places inside the buildings and the areas outside them.
- 5. All housekeeping staff must perform their usual duty and in so doing focus on cleaning staircase railings, doorknobs, doors, and push buttons outside and inside the elevators with disinfectants.
- 6. Food and beverage shops in the Institute building can open to sell only takeaway food and drinks to be consumed elsewhere.
