

## Chulabhorn Royal Academy Chulabhorn Graduate Institute Announcement on Measures to Control the COVID-19 Infection No. 5

Considering the current prevalence of COVID-19, which has been declared a dangerous communicable disease by the Ministry of Public Health with a view to reducing the prospect of its spread to various areas and places, together with the declaration by the Prime Minister with the cabinet approval of an emergency situation in all areas of the Kingdom of Thailand from 26 March to 30 April 2020, regulations have been issued, pursuant to Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005) (No. 1), dated 25 March 2020, on the closure of venues vulnerable to infection with the disease.

The Governor of Bangkok, with the approval of the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration (BMA)'s Committee on Communicable Diseases, has thus revoked the BMA Announcement on Temporary Closure of Venues (No. 2), dated 21 March 2020, and the BMA Announcement on Temporary Closure of Venues (No. 3), dated 21 March 2020, and issued the BMA Announcement on Temporary Closure of Venues (No. 4), dated 27 March 2020. Section 15 of this Announcement orders the closure of educational institutions at all levels from 28 March to 30 April 2020.

In compliance with the BMA Announcement on Temporary Closure of Venues (No. 4), dated 27 March 2020, the Chulabhorn Graduate Institute has ordered an extension of its closure and the absence from work of its personnel from 13 April 2020 to 30 April 2020.
