

## Chulabhorn Royal Academy Chulabhorn Graduate Institute Announcement On Measures to Control the COVID-19 Infection No. 6

The Chulabhorn Graduate Institute Announcement on the Measures to Control the COVID-19 Infection No. 5 has ordered an extension of the temporary closure of its buildings from 13 April 2020 to 30 April 2020.

Now in view of the government's announcement dated 28 April 2020 on the extension of the period of emergency situation declaration in all areas of the Kingdom (first extension) from 1 May 2020 to 31 May 2020, and the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation's decision to ease the control measures for higher educational institutions and research units, authorizing the presidents of the institutions and units to consider such a relaxation on a case-by-case basis, the Institute sets forth the following operating procedures:

- 1 The personnel follow a rotating shift schedule consisting of an at least a three-day shift per week at the Institute and a two-day work from home and prepare a weekly report to their superiors.
- 2 Research activities can still be conducted, as deemed necessary, at the laboratory.
- 3 All classroom teaching and learning activities must be suspended and may be continued online, with students being provided with opportunities to obtain online the teaching materials and to raise queries.
- 4 All personnel must observe the safety standards prescribed by the Ministry of Public Health, including maintaining a social distancing, wearing surgical masks and regularly washing hands.
