

Chulabhorn Graduate Institute Announcement

on Measures and Practical Steps for the Surveillance and Control of the COVID-19 Prevalence No. 7

Taking cognizance of reports on the COVID-19 situation in Samut Sakhon and the nearby provinces, including Bangkok, and the announcement of the Office of the Permanent Secretary for the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation on Measures for the Control and Surveillance of the Spread of COVID-19, which has prescribed practical measures for the personnel to prevent the prevalence of the disease, Chulabhorn Graduate Institute, in compliance with such measures, has set forth the following measures and practical steps for the surveillance and control of COVID-19:

- 1. The personnel of the Institute should avoid travelling to risk areas, i.e., the places where COVID-19 cases have been reported by the Ministry of Public Health, and crowded places such as entertainment venues and community malls.
- 2. The personnel who have visited the areas where the COVID-19 prevalence has been reported should notify the Institute of their visit and work from home for 14 days with a view to detecting if they develop any symptoms. If symptoms do develop, they must see a doctor, immediately report the situation to their superior, and prepare a weekly work report to the latter.
- 3. The personnel must strictly maintain social distancing with a view to preventing the spread of COVID-19.
- 4. The personnel must take care of their health by frequently washing their hands with clean water and soap, or alcohol-based hand sanitizer, or disinfectants, and always wearing a clean face mask.
- 5. In coming to work in the Institute building, the personnel must follow the Ministry of Public Health's safety standards, as well as the measures prescribed above by the Institute. Cooperation is also sought from those coming to work in the Institute building in filling in the in-out report form placed in front of the elevator doors or scanning the ThaiChana QR-Code to check-in or check-out the place.
- 6. The personnel should avoid holding or joining any activity, conference, or seminar, where there are may participants, to prevent any infection risk. In case it is really necessary to hold or join an activity, conference, or seminar, where there are many participants, the personnel must stringently follow the measures against the spread of COVID-19.
