

Chulabhorn Graduate Institute Announcement on Guidance for the Prevention and Control of the Spread of COVID-19 No. 9

With reference to Chulabhorn Graduate Institute Announcement on Guidance for the Prevention and Control of the Spread of COVID-19 No. 8, dated 4 January 2021, it is evident that the situation of the COVID-19 prevalence has relentlessly intensified, and in view of the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration Announcement on temporary closure of premises (No. 16), ordering the extension of the closure of all types of educational institutions to 31 January 2021, it is deemed expedient to make this additional announcement on the guidance for the prevention and control of the spread of COVID-19 with a view to minimizing the risk of the Institute's personnel being infected with the disease, as follows:

- 1. The Institute's supporting personnel must adopt a work-from-home shift schedule from 18 to 31 January 2021 with assignments being given and reports prepared for submission to their superior in accordance with the designated form.
- 2. Food and beverage shops in the Institute building can open to sell food and drinks, and arrangements be made for social distancing of at least 1.5-meters between individuals taking food and drinks in the shops.

The announcement comes into effect from the day of its issuance onwards, and further announcement will be made in case of any change in the present situation.
