Chulabhorn Graduate Institute Announcement On Measures to Control the COVID-19 Infection No. 11

With reference to Chulabhorn Graduate Institute Announcement on Measures and Practical Steps for the Surveillance and Control of the COVID-19 Prevalence No. 10, dated 26 January 2021, it is evident that the situation of the COVID-19 prevalence has relentlessly intensified. It is therefore deemed appropriate to announce a guidance for better prevention and control of COVID-19 with a view to reducing the risk of being infected with the disease, as follows:

- 1. The personnel follow work from home from 10-25 April 2021 and prepare a weekly report to their superiors.
 - 2. Research activities can still be conducted, as deemed necessary, at the laboratory.
- 3. All classroom teaching and learning activities must be suspended and may be continued online, with students being provided with opportunities to obtain online the teaching materials and to raise queries.
- 4. All personnel must observe the safety standards prescribed by the Ministry of Public Health, including maintaining a social distancing, wearing surgical masks and regularly washing hands.

The announcement comes into effect from the day of its issuance onwards, and further announcement will be made in case of any change in the current situation.
