**Qualifying Examination Committee for Academic Year 2021  
for Chemical Sciences Program (Chemical Biology)**

In order to proceed with Qualifying Examination for Academic Year 2021 for students who are studying Doctor of Philosophy Program in Chemical Sciences Program (Chemical Biology). Pursuant to article 8 (1) (9) of the Chulabhorn Royal Academy Regulation on the Administration of the Chulabhorn Graduate Institute 2016 and the resolution of the Academic Committee Meeting 5/2019 on October 9<sup>th</sup>, 2019, the Qualifying Examination Committee for Chemical Sciences Program (Chemical Biology) is appointed as follows;

The qualifying examination committee is tasked with the following responsibilities:

1. Setting the date for both fundamental and specialized knowledge examinations
2. Issuing an announcement on the doctoral qualifying examination
3. Determining the criteria for the doctoral qualifying examination
4. The chairperson of the qualifying examination committee should make an arrangement for the committee meeting to discuss relevant issues, namely
  - 4.1 Considering the fundamental and specialized courses
  - 4.2 Designating a committee member who will be responsible for coordinating with the course coordinators for the exam questions, together with a committee member who will collect the exam papers before and after the examination

4.3 Nominating a committee member who will sort out the exam papers and hand them over to the examiners assigned to mark the completed exam papers on the specific topics in the course being examined

5. Finalizing the result of the qualifying examination in each course with a view to assessing those who have fulfilled the qualifying exam criteria within two weeks after the completion of the examination

6. Issuing the list of students who have passed the doctoral qualifying examination

7. Considering an arrangement for a reexamination for those who have not met the qualifying exam criteria
